



Curly in Bloom Scholarship Fund – Terms & Conditions

By applying for the Curly in Bloom Scholarship Fund, applicants agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Eligibility

- Applicants must be enrolled at a registered Tertiary Institution or Technical College within South Africa. Proof of enrollment is required.
- Applicants must be on track to complete their studies by **31 December 2025**.
- Applicants must be 18 years or older at the time of entry and in possession of a valid South African Identity Document.
- This opportunity is open to Black South African females, inclusive of those who identify as Black, Colored, or Brown.
- Employees, family members, or associates of Sunpac (Pty) Ltd and Curly in Bloom are not eligible to enter.

2. Competition Details

- To enter: Submit a typed 300-to-400-word (maximum one A4 page) motivation explaining why you should be awarded the scholarship.
- Entries must be emailed to **curlsinbloom@sunpac.co.za** together with proof of purchase of any Curly in Bloom product (excluding 50ml sachets).
- Only one entry per person will be accepted.
- Entries close at 23h59 on Sunday, 30 November 2025.
- The duration of the competition may be shortened or extended at the discretion of the organiser.

3. Prize Breakdown

A total of R50 000 in scholarship funding will be awarded as follows:

- **1st Place Winner:** R30 000 contribution towards tuition fees, plus a 3-month internship at Sunpac (Pty) Ltd and Mentorship with Taryn Gill (Creator of Curls in Bloom)
- **2nd Place Winner:** R15 000 contribution towards tuition fees.
- **3rd Place Winner:** R5 000 contribution towards study expenses such as fees, travel, or books.

Note:

- Tuition contributions (1st and 2nd place prizes) will be paid directly to the registered institution on behalf of the winners.
- The 3rd place prize will be paid directly to the winner.
- Prizes are not transferable and may not be deferred.

3. Social Media Competitions

In addition to the scholarship funding, R3,000 in cash prizes will be given away on Instagram through competitions, awarded to 3 winners (R1,000 each)

4. Internship Requirements

- The 1st place winner must be willing to complete their 3-month internship at Sunpac offices in Woodmead, Johannesburg.
- Accommodation and transport will not be provided; however, a small travel stipend will be offered at an amount determined by the company.

5. Media Consent

- Applicants agree to allow Curls in Bloom to use their names, images, and participation details on social media and other marketing platforms during the competition and internship period.
- These images may remain on Curls in Bloom's platforms indefinitely.
- Additional consent will be requested for new images or videos used in future campaigns.

6. Winner Selection

- The selection panel's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Winners will be chosen based on the strongest motivational submissions.
- Winners will be contacted directly via email and/or phone within 10 days of the competition closing.
- If, after 3 attempts, the winner cannot be reached, the prize will be awarded to the next eligible participant.
- The Top 3 winners will be invited to a press conference in Johannesburg on Tuesday, 3 February 2026, where prizes will be officially presented.
- To claim the prize, winners must provide:
 1. Proof of enrollment
 2. Institution banking details (with proof of account). However, the 3rd prize winner must provide their personal banking details (with proof of account).
 3. An account statement from the institution
 4. A copy of their SA Identity Document
 5. Proof of purchase for 2 or more Curls In Bloom products

7. General

- The scholarship may be withdrawn if any information provided is found to be false or misleading.
- Curls in Bloom reserves the right to amend or cancel the scholarship if necessary.

- Official winners will be announced on Monday, 15 December 2025, on Curls in Bloom's official platforms.

8. Privacy

- All personal information provided by applicants will be collected and processed in accordance with the Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA).
- Information collected will only be used for purposes directly related to the scholarship programme, including verifying eligibility, communicating with applicants, processing entries, awarding prizes, and facilitating the internship (where applicable).
- Personal details such as names, contact information, proof of enrollment, and identification documents will be stored securely and accessed only by authorised Sunpac (Pty) Ltd and Curls in Bloom personnel to administer the scholarship.
- We will not sell, distribute, or share personal information with any third party unless required to do so by law or with the applicant's explicit written consent.
- Applicants' details will be retained only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which they were collected and will then be securely deleted or anonymised.

9. Disclaimers & Liability

- It is the participant's responsibility to ensure their entry is received before the closing date. Late entries, regardless of reason, will not be considered.
- Neither Sunpac (Pty) Ltd, Curls in Bloom, nor their affiliates will be held responsible for any technical failures, system malfunctions, network issues, or other problems preventing timely entry submission.
